6. Starting order	For Task 1 the starting order per class will be decided by drawing lots. From the second valid task onwards, the top 10 pilots of the current overall ranking per class in the competition will be starting in reverse order. From position 11 onwards, pilots will be starting in ranking order.																		
7. Repeat starts	A pilot who has landed may re-start. Repeat starters are to start at the end of the regular start-list in the order they report to the launch manager. Should the second class already have begun to launch, then repeat starters will be added to the end of the overall list (mixed start order)

Participants	<p>The overall number of pilots is limited to 75</p> <p>Dutch Championship: 25 participant slots are reserved for Dutch citizens</p> <p>State Championship North-East: Pilots with permanent residence in the following German states: Niedersachsen, Nordrhein-Westfalen, Schleswig-Holstein, Hamburg, Bremen, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Sachsen-Anhalt, Brandenburg, Berlin, Thüringen, and Sachsen are eligible to participate.</p> <p>International German Flatlands: In addition to the 25 slots reserved for Dutch citizens, 10 slots are reserved for non-German participants.</p> <p>A minimum number of 25 pilots is required.</p>
15. Qualification	<p>If more than 75 pilots have registered by 01 May2016, the competition board will choose the participants in regard of their FAI-CIVIL-ranking, their DHV-XC ranking and other online competition rankings.</p> <p>In accordance with FAI regulations,25% of all participant slots will be reserved for non-German Pilots until July 23.</p> <p>Any open slots after June 1st will be assigned in the order of payments received.</p> <p>The competition board reserves the right to raise the number of participants and to fill open slots and to change allocations in order to fill free slots.</p>
16. Documentation	Documentation is to be done by GPS tracklog with altitude recording (Every pilot has to bring an appropriate connection cable for his instrument. A backup instrument is recommended) For scoring, especially when air–space violations are detected, only the first submitted track (Master GPS) will be validated and the recorded GPS altitude is decisive.

Pilots must provide appropriate test protocol documentation. • Helmet tested in accordance with EN 966 • Valid license or foreign license with additional endorsements for microlight tow launching. • Valid third party insurance. • FAI-Sport license for 2016 (must be valid at registration!). • Signed Liability and Participation agreement documents for DHV competitions. <p>All documents will be examined at registration.</p>

Starting fee	<p>The organizer will select the participants of the competition according to the criteria mentioned in point 15 and inform them by mail until May 1st 2016.</p> <p>After that information, the participants have to transfer the starting fee to the organizers account until June 1st 2016.</p> <p>Any open slots after June 1st will be assigned in the order of payments received.</p> <p>The starting fee is 160,-€ if registration is completed until June 15th and 200,-€ thereafter.</p> <p>Payments via bank transfer to the following account :</p> <p>Drachenflieger-Club Berlin e.V. 24. Included in start fee	<p>Pilot sheet with all important telephone numbers and radio frequencies, scoring; retrieve coordination, pilot T-shirts, pilots party with buffet and band, trophies. A paramedic service is available during tasks.</p> <p>Breakfast is offered daily at cost price!</p>
25. Towing charges	<p>In addition to the starting fees, Pilots have to pay for their microlight tows daily at end of flight sign in. Towing charges will be approximately 20 -25 € per tow to 500 m. Exact prices will be set and publicized according to fuel prices at the start of the competition.</p>

26. Registration	Online-registration per www.dhv.de or via registration form. Last minute entries will only be possible should there be less than 75 pilots already registered.
27. GPS-Registration	Saturday, August 6th, 2016 from 5:00 PM - 10:00 PM at the competition office. After each task please return your GPS instrument as soon as possible after landing!
28. Retrieval	Every pilot is responsible for the organization of his/her retrieval!
29. Call Back / Check in	Every participant must check in via SMS and run report after landing before the deadline set during the task briefing. All participants who have not checked in will be searched for with all available resources. Participants must pay all costs for search actions themselves.
